EU response

As of 15 September, 17:00 UTC

€ 5.7 million humanitarian funding

Libya requested assistance in the evening of 12 September. Following offers of in-kind-assistance, modules and experts from 9 EU member states (AT, BE, DE, FI, FR, IT, NL, RO, SE) have been accepted:

- 4** truck/machine
- 10** Hydro pumps
- > 6 000** WASH items
- > 4 500** Food/water items

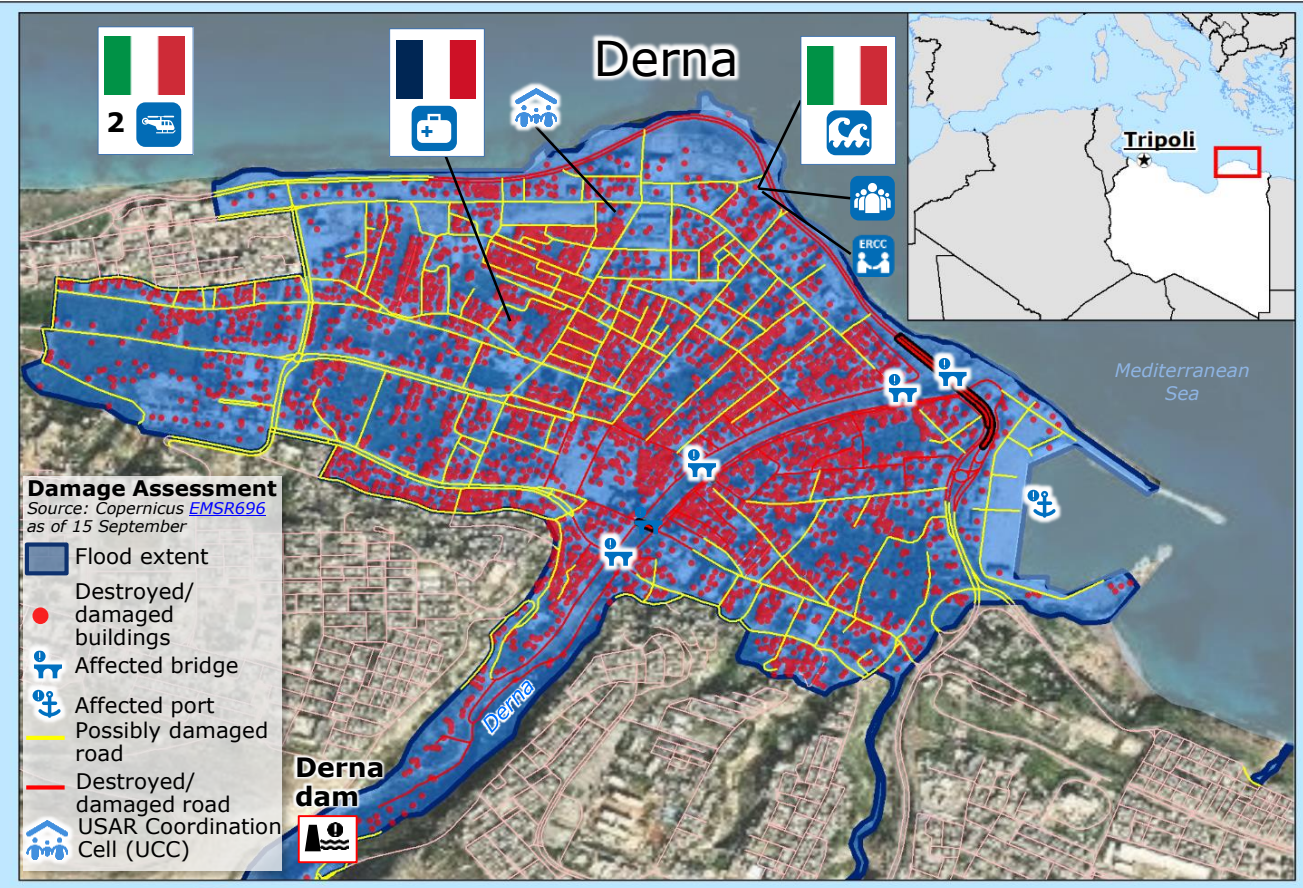

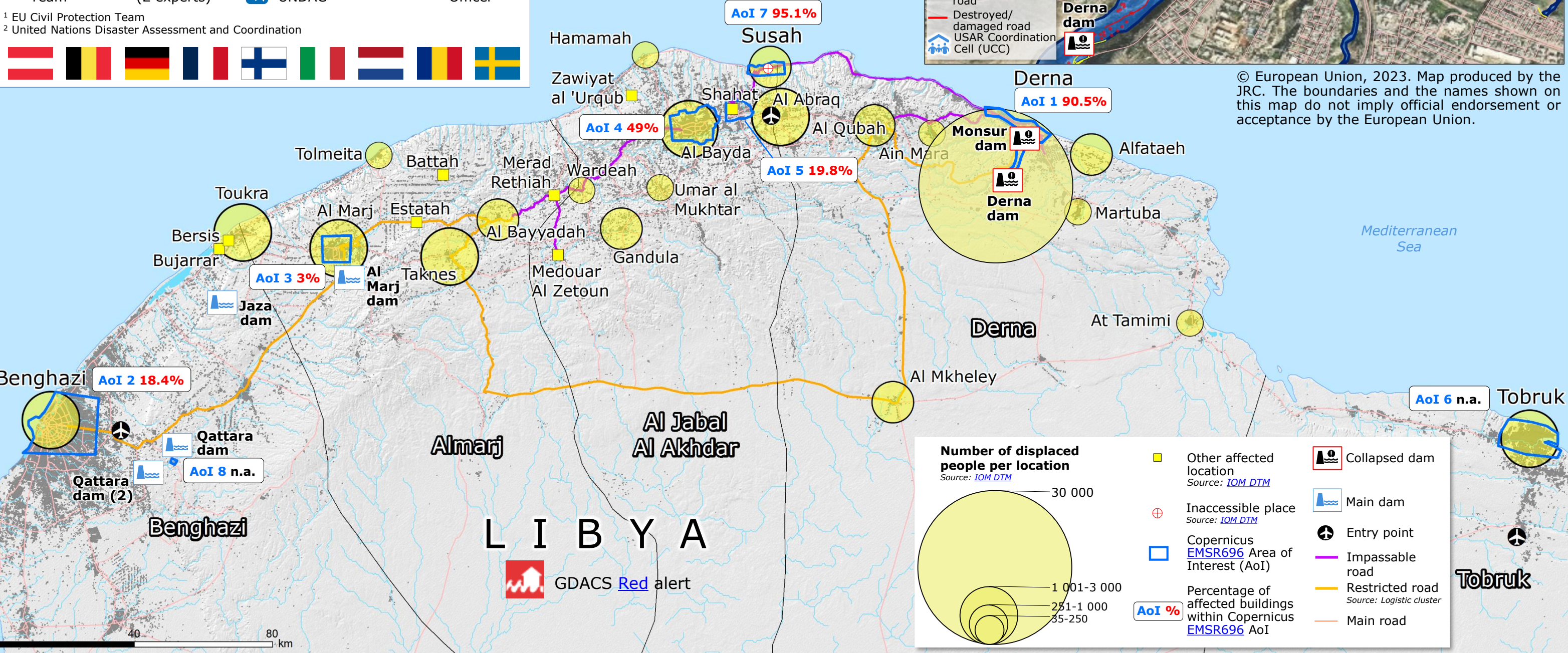
