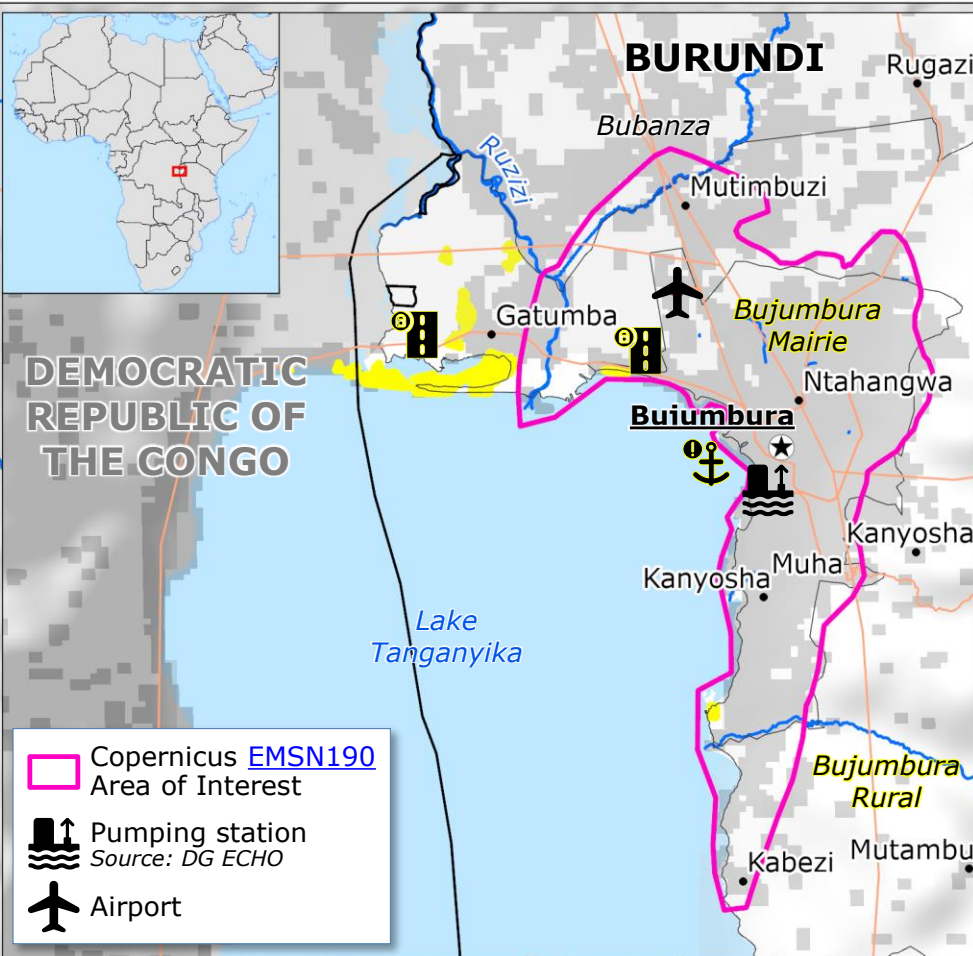


Burundi | Recent severe weather and potential Lake Tanganyika overflow



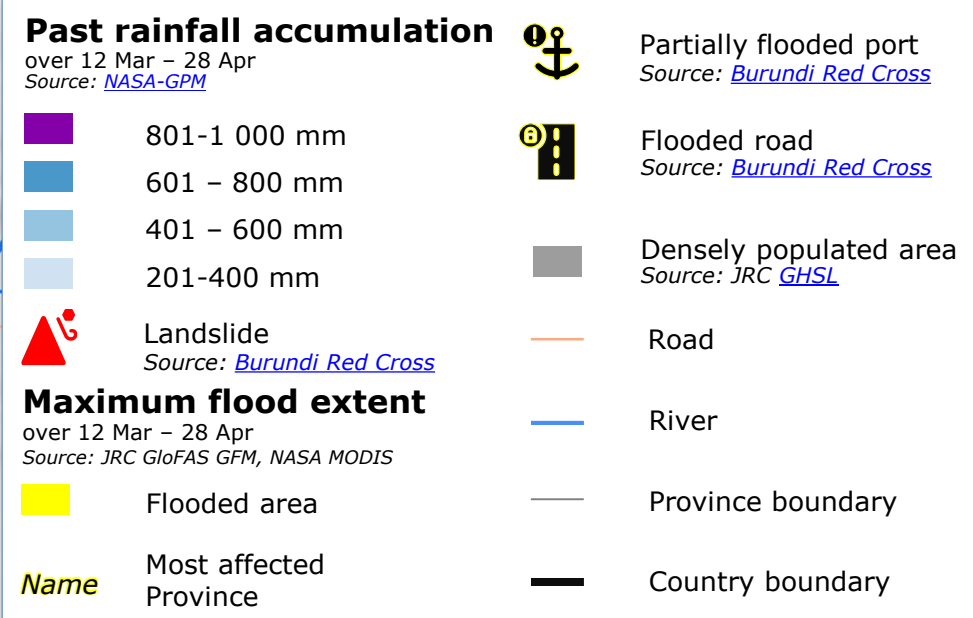
