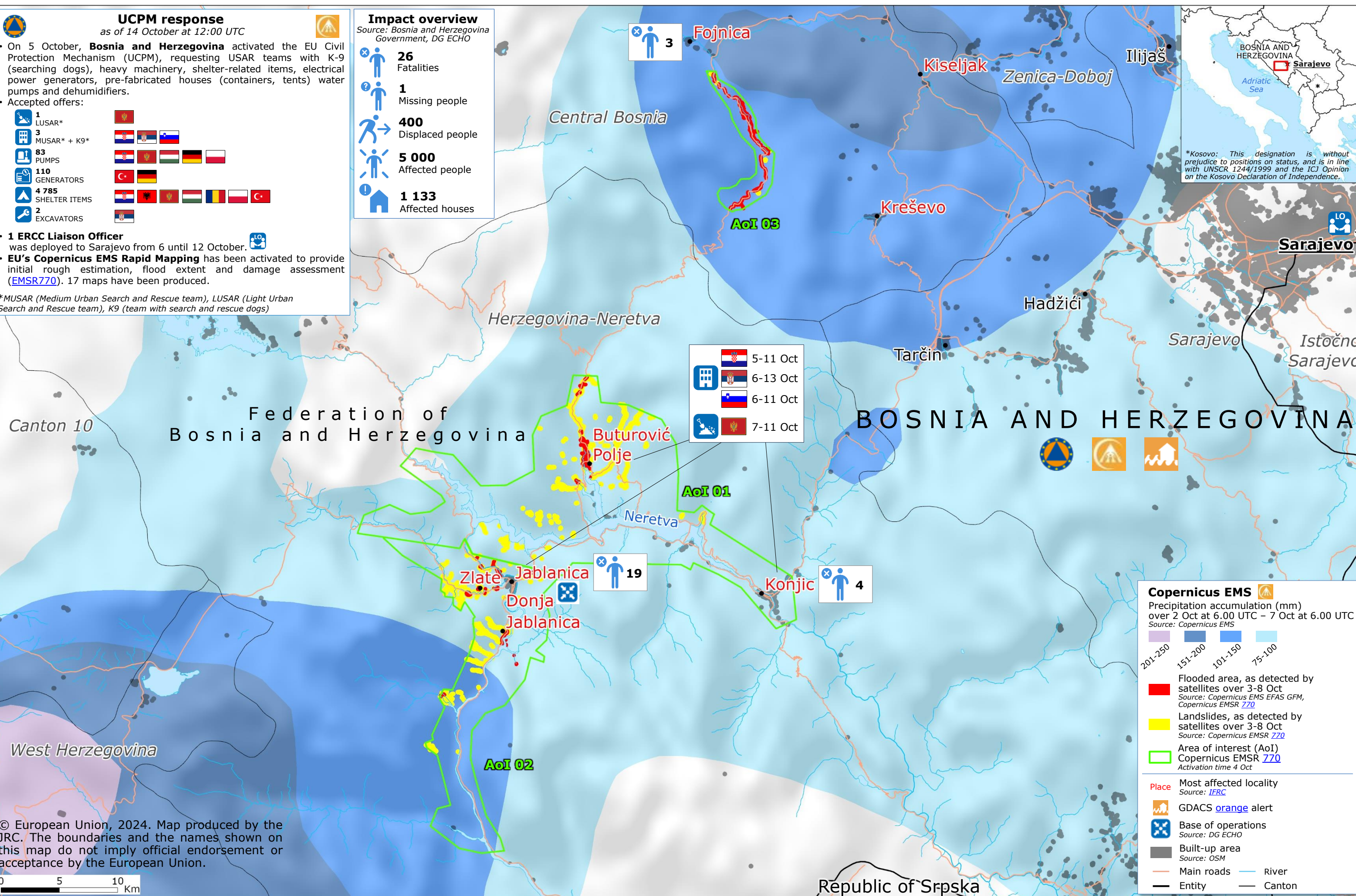
- On 5 October, **Bosnia and Herzegovina** activated the EU Civil Protection Mechanism (UCPM), requesting USAR teams with K-9 (searching dogs), heavy machinery, shelter-related items, electrical power generators, pre-fabricated houses (containers, tents) water pumps and dehumidifiers.
- Accepted offers:
 - 1 LUSAR*
 - 3 MUSAR* + K9*
 - 83 PUMPS
 - 110 GENERATORS
 - 4 785 SHELTER ITEMS
 - 2 EXCAVATORS
- 1 ERCC Liaison Officer was deployed to Sarajevo from 6 until 12 October.
- EU's Copernicus EMS Rapid Mapping has been activated to provide initial rough estimation, flood extent and damage assessment (EMSR770). 17 maps have been produced.
