



SITUATION

- KUJIRA made landfall in Wanning city, south-east Hainan province, on 22 June, 18.50 local time (10.50 UTC), as a Tropical Storm. It then moved north-west over the island of Hainan. It affected the island with strong winds and heavy rainfall. Authorities had previously evacuated nearly 40 000 people for precautionary reasons.
- On 23 June, at 6.00 UTC, KUJIRA's centre was located approx. 120km from Quang Ninh, north-eastern Vietnam with maximum sustained winds of 65km/h.
- KUJIRA is expected to weaken and make landfall on 23 June afternoon, in Quang Ninh.
- As of 23 June, there is a Blue Warning for Typhoon, a Yellow Warning for heavy rain in Hainan and in southern Guangdong and Guangxi, China and a Tropical Storm Warning for Vietnam.
