

It then started moving west-northwest over the Bay of Bengal towards eastern India, strengthening. On 26 October at 6.00 UTC its center was located approx. 560 km east of Kakinada city (Andhra Pradesh State, India) and it had max. sustained wind speed of 93 km/h (Tropical Storm). Over the next 24 h it is forecast to continue moving west-northwest


