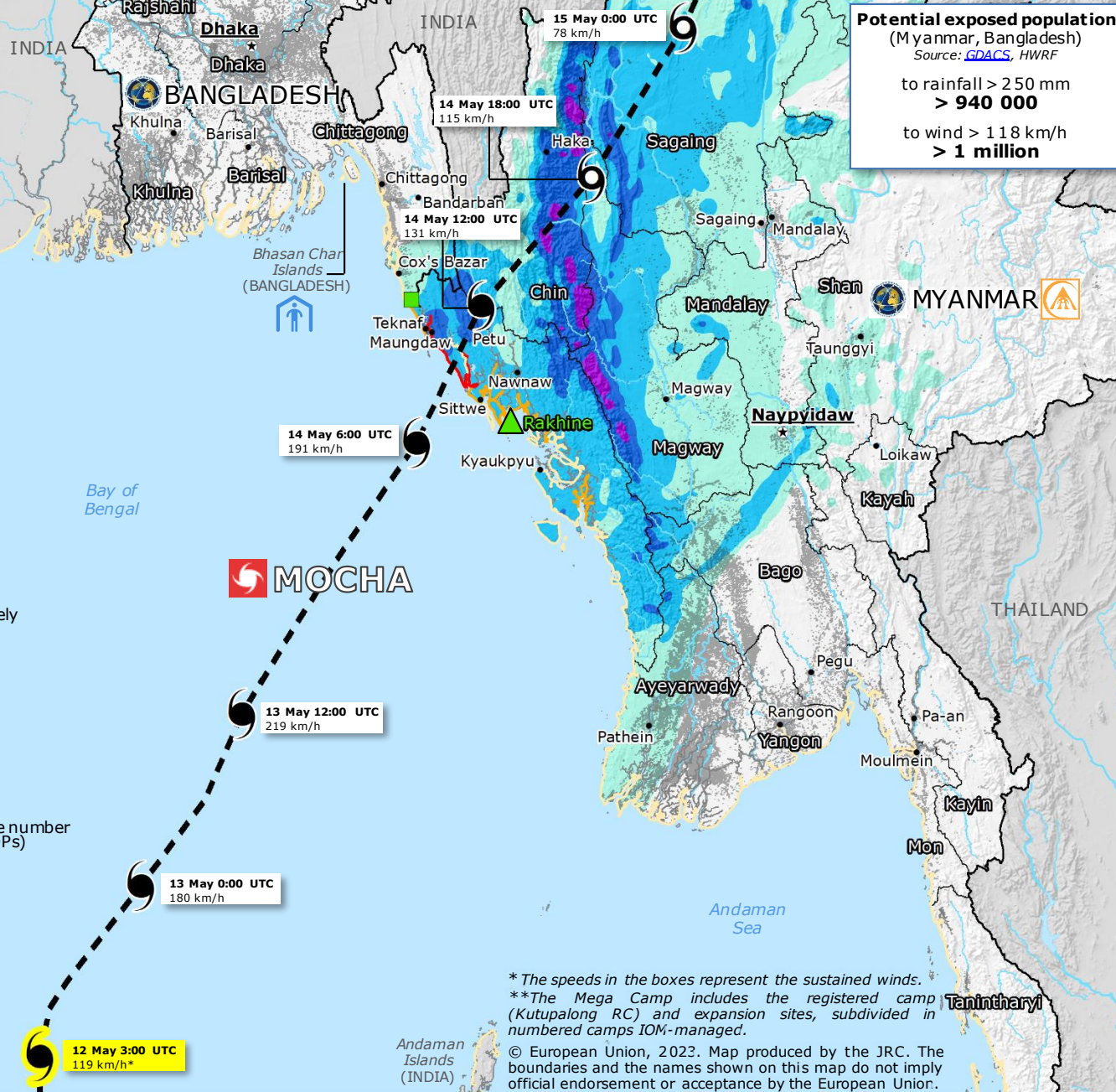
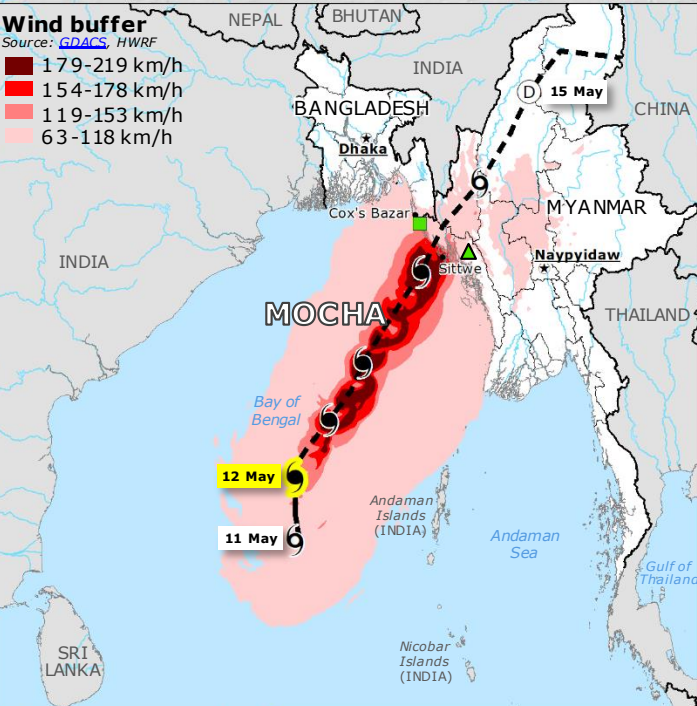


Myanmar, Bangladesh | Tropical Cyclone MOCHA
