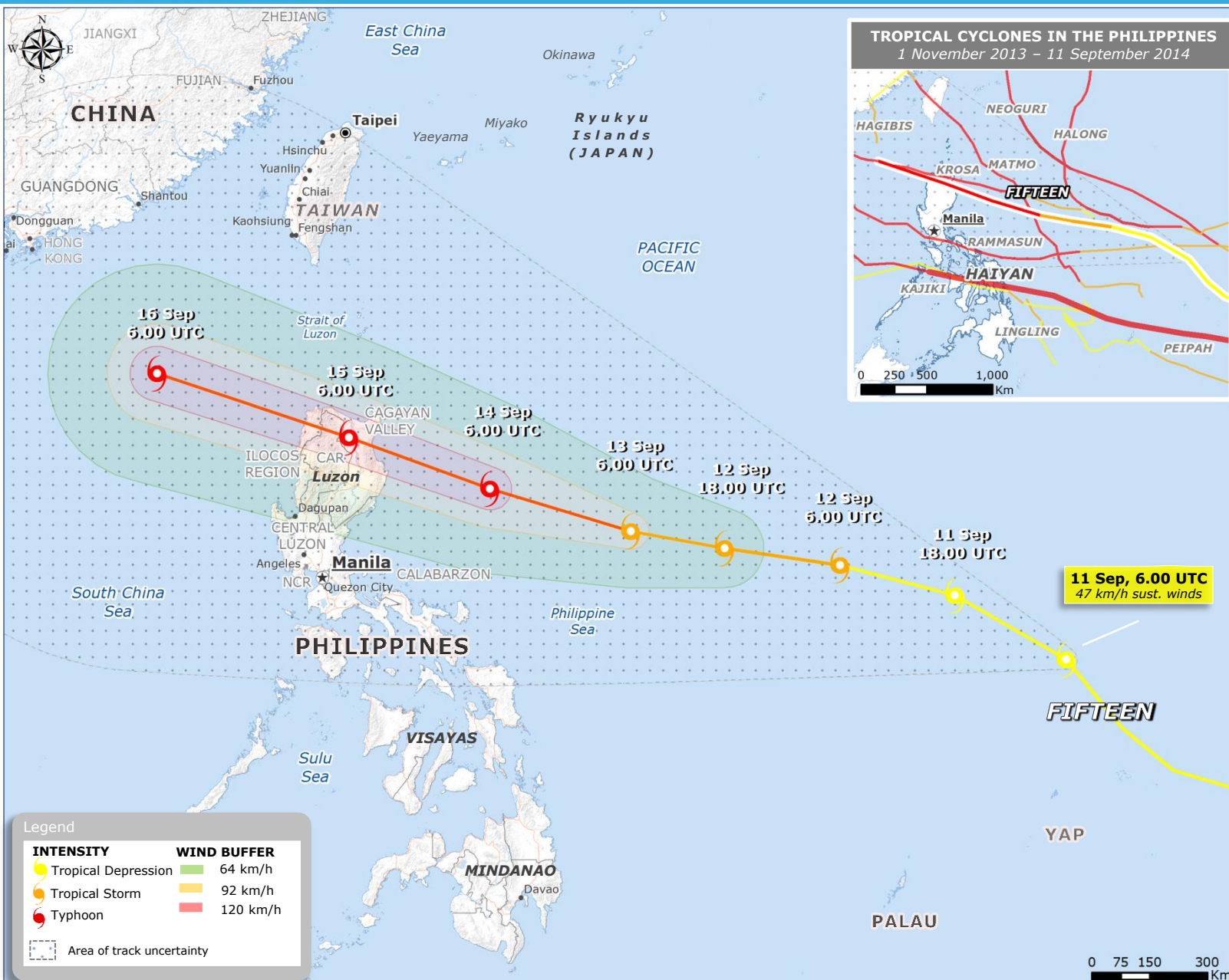


11 September 2014: Philippines - Tropical Cyclone FIFTEEN



SITUATION

- Tropical Cyclone FIFTEEN formed on 10 September over the south-western Pacific Ocean and started moving west in the general direction of the Philippines.
- On 11 September, 06.00 UTC, FIFTEEN was a tropical depression and its centre was located approx. 1 400 km east of the Philippines in the Pacific Ocean and about 350 km north of Yap, Micronesia.
- In the next 48 h, FIFTEEN is forecast to continue moving north-west towards the Philippines, remaining over water and intensifying.
- According to the data of 11 September, 6.00 UTC, FIFTEEN may reach northern Philippines on 15 September as a Typhoon, however the uncertainty of the forecast track/intensity is still high.
