On 11 June, Cyprus activated the EU Civil Protection Mechanism (UCPM) requesting aerial firefighting planes. On the same day, Greece sent two planes to support the response operations.

2 Canadair CL-415 (ECP)


According to Cyprus National Authorities:

- Active fires are currently under control
- An estimated area of 650 hectares was burnt
- Involved capacities: aerial firefighting modules, including large and small firefighting planes and firefighting helicopters, firefighting vehicles and personnel.


