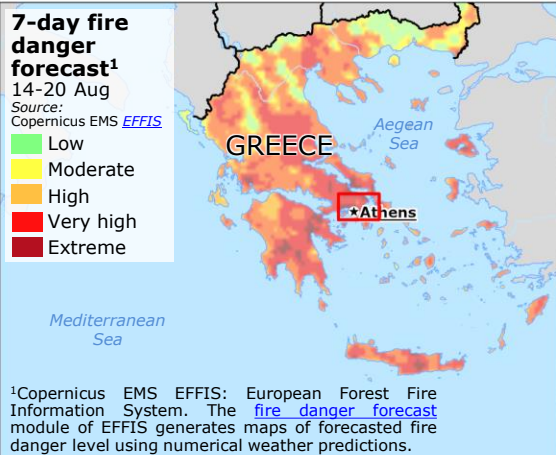


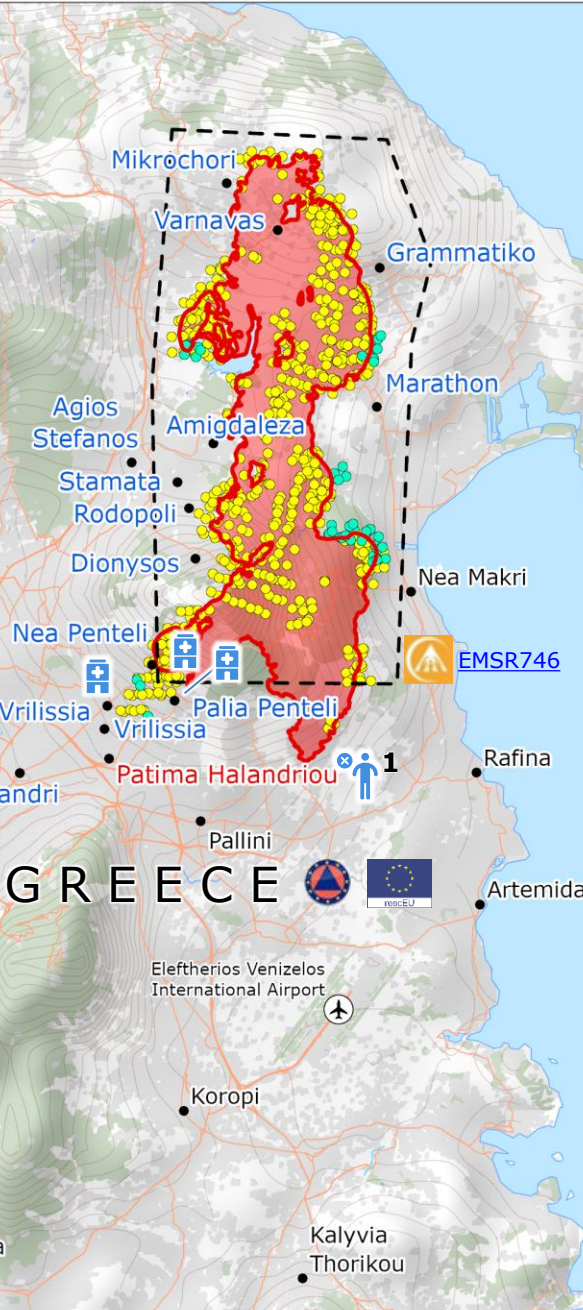
Greece | Wildfires and EU response

UCPM response as of 13 August

- On 12 August, Greece activated the EU Civil Protection Mechanism (UCPM), requesting 6 firefighting scooping planes, 2 helicopters and 8 Ground Forest Fire Fighting modules with vehicles (GFFF-V).
- Offered response to Greece:**
 - 1 x 5 pax [rescEU](#)
 - 1 x 75 pax + 32 vehicles
 - 1 x 44 pax + 8 vehicles
 - 2 x 14 pax [rescEU](#)
 - 4 x 184 pax
 - 1 x 35 pax + 10 vehicles
 - 1 x 7 pax
 - 1 x 26 pax + 13 vehicles
- Prepositioned GFFF teams also active in the response (more [info](#)):**
 - 1 x 40 pax + 8 vehicles
 - 1 x 20 pax + 4 vehicles
 - 1 x 20 pax + 5 vehicles
- The **Copernicus Emergency Management Service** was activated in rapid mapping mode ([EMSR746](#)) on 12 August to provide initial rough estimation, fire extent and damage assessment.
- 2 ERCC Liaison Officers** were deployed on 13 August to Athens.
